HOW DOES THE MAGIC HAPPEN?

I thought you might like to know how everything gets in place before the decorators arrive. The TRFA board works yearround to raise funds and plan for this week. Our design contest starts in November (Yes, that is before this float even has one flower!) and ends in January. In February Tim Estes of Fiesta Parade Floats and two judges from Destination Art in Torrance review the contest submissions and select the top 4. The board votes on them and pays the entrance fee to Tournament for the parade. In March Fiesta Parade Floats presents the final design to the City's Citizens Development and Enrichment Committee. If they approve the design, it goes to the City Council for approval. Fiesta draws up the contract and after it is signed, they begin work on the structure of the float. TRFA starts the process of designing and ordering the shirts, pins and patches. We continue with fundraising and having booths and tables at community events. In the fall we order the buses from TUSD and make transportation arrangements for the float riders. We inventory our supplies and determine what will be needed. This year I accompanied Jan Staws to Irwindale on December 15th. We had extra keys made for our storage container. (It is ordered by Fiesta and paid for by TRFA. It comes with 2 keys, but Fiesta keeps one and it's always better to have more!) Next, we went to Dominos, Subway and KFC and ordered and paid for all the lunches. Our next stop was Smart and Final to order all our supplies and arrange to pick them up. It was quite a project! On Wednesday the 19th my brother and I filled the back of his pickup with all our equipment at the TRFA storage shed at Wilson Park and drove it all to Irwindale and unloaded it at our container. Next, we went to Pasadena and picked up 150 Parade programs. TRFA always sends someone up to get them and save us the \$50.00 in shipping! On the 22nd, Jan and I returned to Irwindale picked up our order at Smart and Final and unloaded it at our container. Our tables and chairs had been delivered so we set up the tables where we wanted them. We were as ready as we could get until the big day! During the week Roseanne arrived early every day and started the coffee. Jan and Roseanne made runs to the store to refill the ice and fruit during the week. Our great volunteers kept the tent running the entire time the decorators were there. Lynda Kraemer our "Rose Vial Lady" brought the labels and they were put on the vials. They went on the float the last night. We kept the tent open until about midnight on the 30th. Our last hardy decorators finished around 1:30 a.m.

The morning of the 31st is judging. All the floats are finished. The float riders are in place and each float in turn is started for 5 minutes and does everything it will do in the parade while the judges mark their sheets. After judging it is time to pack up all our equipment and take it back to Torrance! Are we done? Not quite. After the floats arrive at the parade route Don and Mary Jo Kohlmiller come with a "patch Kit" to repair anything damaged during the drive from Irwindale to Pasadena. They have been doing this for many years. TRFA has people with the float all night to keep people from trying to take a souvenir from the float. This year it was Roseanne Villalobos and Melissa De la Vara. For the last several years we have sold a parade package with bus transportation and grand stand seats. Bev and Lynn go to Wilson Park in the wee hours and check in the bus riders and see them off. Then we go home stay awake long enough to see our float and go back to bed! Now were done!! (Well except for cleaning up the shed, figuring out expenses and income and discussing what worked and what didn't......)

Tuesday, January 8th is our first board meeting of 2019 and we can start all over again! We can always use help so if any of this sounds interesting to you come join us. It's a lot of work, but it's all worth it to see that float go down the street.
