

The group toured the Tournament House. The House, an elegant Italian Renaissance-style mansion, was presented to the city of Pasadena in 1958 by the William Wrigley family with the understanding that it would become the permanent headquarters for the Tournament of Roses. The history of the house is grand and decorated in the period of 1906; with many wonderful donated pieces, from the Royal Courts, Grand Marshals, Tournament Presidents and Rose Bowl game memorabilia. Upstairs in the hallway, there is a glass case with various crowns from the past gueens and if vou stand just right, you can have your picture taken so it looks like you are wearing the crown.

The day concluded with a walk through the gardens that include more than 1,500 varieties of roses, camellias and annuals.
