Irene Valdez was a long time Torrance float decorator. Since she passed away her family has continued the decorating tradition and places a rose vial on the City of Torrance Rose float in her memory each year.

Among the family members who decorated our 2023 float was Irene's grandson Navy chief Petty Officer Brian Zacha and his wife Chief Petty Officer Jessica Zacha and 2 of their 4 children. At the time they were decorating Brian was assigned to the Naval Base in San Diego while Jessica was on leave from her assignment at the base in Yokouska, Japan as a hospital corpsman.

It is not unusual to have families decorate or honor a loved one with a rose vial. What makes this family special is that while they were decorating on December 29, 2022 they were also packing and getting ready to move to Japan on January 9, 2023! While on leave and in the middle of preparing for a move they joined their other family members to continue the tradition of decorating the Torrance float.

Brian retired from the Navy on January 23rd and has returned to school as well as becoming a househusband and caring for their children ages 19, 16, 4 and 1. He said it was important that they spent the time before they left with the family honoring his grandmother's memory. Brian wanted his teenage sons be a part of the experience and hopes they will continue the family tradition.
